- (b) Service in the Senate and service in the House of Representatives prior to November 3, 2010, shall not disqualify, in whole or in part, a person from service in those bodies following that date. A partial term of more than two years after the previous election constitutes a full term for purposes of this amendment.
- (c) The Legislature may enact general law consistent with this amendment to implement this amendment.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide a three consecutive term limit on persons serving in the Legislature.

"Proposed by Act ."

This description shall be followed by the following 27 language:
