Existing law provides that in the letting of public contracts in which any state, county, or municipal funds are utilized, preference shall be given to resident contractors, and a nonresident bidder domiciled in a state having laws granting preference to local contractors shall be awarded Alabama public contracts only on the same basis as the nonresident bidder's state awards contracts to Alabama contractors bidding under similar circumstances.

Relating to the awarding of public contracts; to require each awarding authority of certain public works contracts to give preference to a bidder who has a workforce that consists of at least 50 percent of all workers to be employed on the public works project who hold an Alabama driver's license or an identification card issued by the

1 Alabama Department of Public Safety, has a valid Alabama 2 business license, and uses vehicles which are used primarily for the public works projects that are registered and 3 partially apportioned in Alabama; to provide that at least 50 percent of design professionals shall have a valid Alabama 5 driver's license or an identification card issued by the 6 7 Alabama Department of Public Safety; to provide that the service of at least 25 percent of the suppliers of materials 8 used for the public work be located in the State of Alabama; 9 10 to require each bidder who is awarded a public works contract to maintain and make available for inspection records 11 12 concerning payroll related to the public works project; and to 13 allow the Governor, in times of emergencies, to waive the 14 provisions of this act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1. (a) The awarding authority of a public works contract in which any state, county, or municipal funds are used, except those contracts funded in whole or in part with funds received from a federal agency, shall give preference to a bidder who:

- (1) Has a workforce that consists of at least 50 percent of all workers to be employed on the public works project who hold an Alabama driver's license or an identification card issued by the Alabama Department of Public Safety.
 - (2) Has a valid Alabama business license.

1 (3) Uses vehicles which are used primarily for the 2 public works project that are registered and partially 3 apportioned in Alabama.

- (4) If employing design professionals for the public work, at least 50 percent of the design professionals shall have a valid Alabama driver's license or an identification card issued by the Alabama Department of Public Safety.
- (5) Uses the service of at least 25 percent of the suppliers of materials used for the public work who are located in the State of Alabama.
- (b) Each bidder who is awarded a public works contract pursuant to this section shall maintain and make available for inspection records concerning payrolls related to the public works project.
- any requirement of this act if he or she finds that there exists an emergency which threatens the public health, safety, or welfare and the waiver is necessary to meet the emergency. The Governor, or his or her designee, shall require the award of each contract to be made with such competition as is practicable under the circumstances. The Governor, or his or her designee, shall file with the Secretary of State a statement of facts constituting the emergency for each waiver issued under this section, and a statement of the basis for selection of each contractor under the emergency procedure.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
