21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. Section 25-9-11 of the Code of Alabama
23	1975, is amended to read as follows:
24	"§25-9-11.
25	"Each applicant for a mine foreman's certificate of
26	competency shall satisfy all of the following requirements:

1 "(1) Be a citizen of the United States or, if not a 2 citizen of the United States, a person who is legally present 3 in the United States with appropriate documentation from the 4 federal government.

"(2) Be at least 23 years old.

6 "(3) Have had four years practical mining experience 7 or have had three years equivalent practical experience credit 8 in or around coal mines and be a graduate of a school 9 accredited by the American Association of Universities or have 10 satisfactorily completed an associate degree program in mine 11 technology at an approved state trade school or university. 12 "a. A graduate of a school accredited by the

13American Association of Universities shall be considered the14equivalent of two years practical experience for mine foreman.

15 "b. A satisfactorily completed associate degree
 16 program at an approved state trade school or university shall
 17 be considered the equivalent of one year experience for mine
 18 foreman.

"(4) Present with his or her application an affidavit of his or her meeting the foregoing requirements and of his or her good moral character and known temperate habits, which affidavit shall be signed by three reputable citizens, at least one of whom shall be the holder of a mine foreman's certificate.

25 "(5) Present with his or her application an
26 affidavit that he or she is not a member of any political

1 party or organization that advocates the overthrow of the 2 government of the United States by force.

3 "(6) All applicants shall be able to read and write
4 proficiently the English language and shall furnish the
5 regulatory authority with a notarized statement from previous
6 employers detailing the length of service and type of work
7 performed in various mines."

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 9 first day of the third month following its passage and 10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
