Relating to Talladega County; providing that commissioned deputies of the sheriff's department, upon retirement after a period of ten years or more of service, may receive without cost a retired badge and his or her service pistol.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. This act shall apply only to Talladega 10 County.

Section 2. Any person employed as a commissioned deputy of the Sheriff's Office of Talladega County for a period of ten years or more who upon retirement leaves the office in good standing may receive from the office, without cost to him or her, a retired badge, a retired commission card, and his or her service pistol.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
