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Section 1. Section 36-29A-1 of the Code of Alabama
 1975, is amended to read as follows:

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"§36-29A-1.

4 "The Director of Finance shall have the authority to implement a program to provide compensation for employees of 5 6 the state and its agencies, departments, boards, or 7 commissions and members of the Alabama National Guard and Alabama State Defense Force while on active military service 8 for the state who suffer personal injury as a result of 9 10 accidents arising out of and in the course of their state 11 employment or active military service, under such terms and 12 conditions as the Director of Finance shall determine. The 13 said program will be administered by the Division of Risk 14 Management of the Department of Finance, and will take effect on October 1, 1994." 15

16 Section 2. The Military Department may pay medical 17 expenses for members of the National Guard or Alabama State 18 Defense Force who become ill during active military service or 19 who have minor injuries as a direct result of active military 20 service for the state not covered by the State Employees 21 Injury Compensation Program.

Section 3. Section 31-2-85 of the Code of Alabama
1975, is repealed.

24 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the 25 first day of the third month following its passage and 26 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
