To add Section 32-6-1.2 to the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to driver's licenses; to provide that a veteran who meets certain requirements may receive a veteran's driver's license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 32-6-1.2 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

\$32-6-1.2.

- (a) The driver's license of a resident of this state who is an eligible honorably discharged veteran pursuant to Section 32-6-350(c) as evidenced by the veteran's DD Form 214, upon request of the eligible veteran, shall have the word veteran displayed on the license.
- (b) The Director of Public Safety shall establish by rule the proof required to be produced by an applicant for a veteran's driver's license. Except as provided in subsection (a), the contents of the license of a veteran shall be the same as for any other license.
- (c) (b) The Department of Public Safety may not impose any charge in addition to the driver's license fee for the issuance or renewal of a veteran's driver's license.
