Section 35-19-2, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows: 9 "\$35-19-2. 10 11 "The following terms shall have the following 12 meanings: 13 "(1) ACTIVITY AND USE LIMITATIONS. Restrictions or 14 obligations created under this chapter with respect to real 15 property. 16 "(2) AGENCY or DEPARTMENT. The Alabama Department of 17 Environmental Management. 18 "(3) COMMON INTEREST COMMUNITY. A condominium, cooperative, or other real property with respect to which a 19 20 person, by virtue of the person's ownership of a parcel of 21 real property, is obligated to pay property taxes or insurance 22 premiums, or for maintenance, or improvement of other real 23 property described in a recorded covenant that creates the 24 common interest community.

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1	"(4) DIRECTOR. The Director of the Alabama
2	Department of Environmental Management or his or her
3	designated representative.
4	"(5) ENVIRONMENTAL COVENANT. A servitude arising
5	under an environmental response project that imposes activity
6	and use limitations.
7	"(6) ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE PROJECT. A plan or work
8	performed for environmental remediation of real property and
9	conducted under any of the following programs or situations:
10	"a. Under a federal or state program governing
11	environmental remediation of real property, including Chapter
12	30E of Title 22 <u>, but not</u> includig <u>including Chapter 36 of</u>
13	<u>Title 22</u> .
14	"b. Incident to closure of a solid or hazardous
15	waste management unit, if the closure is conducted with
16	approval of an agency.
17	"c. Under a state voluntary clean-up program
18	authorized in Chapter 30E of Title 22.
19	"(7) HOLDER. The grantee of an environmental
20	covenant as specified in subsection (a) of Section 35-19-3.
21	"(8) PERSON. An individual, corporation, business
22	trust, estate, trust, partnership, limited liability company,
23	association, joint venture, public corporation, government,
24	governmental subdivision, agency, or instrumentality, or any
25	other legal or commercial entity.

1 "(9) RECORD. Used as a noun, means information that 2 is inscribed on a tangible medium or that is stored in an 3 electronic or other medium and is retrievable in perceivable 4 form.

5 "(10) STATE. The State of Alabama."
6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
