8 To require the State Department of Finance to
9 develop and maintain an automated inventory of all facilities
10 and lands owned, leased, rented, or otherwise occupied or
11 maintained by any agency of the state or by the judicial
12 branch.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. (1) The Alabama Department of Finance
15 shall develop and maintain an automated inventory of all
16 facilities and lands owned, leased, rented, or otherwise
17 occupied or maintained by any agency of the state or by the
18 judicial branch. The facilities inventory shall include the
19 location, occupying agency and ownership. The term "facility,"
20 as used in this section, means buildings, structures, and
21 building systems, but does not include facilities of the State
22 Transportation Department. The Department of Transportation
23 shall develop and maintain an inventory of its facilities. The
24 Commission on Higher Education and the State Department of
25 Postsecondary Education, respectively, shall develop and
26 maintain an inventory, in the manner prescribed by the
27 Department of Finance, of all state university and community

1 college facilities and shall make the data available in a
2 format acceptable to the State Department of Finance.

3 The lands inventory shall include the location and
4 ownership.

5 The Department shall utilize any available
6 information from existing inventories of facilities and lands
7 to develop and maintain the inventory required by this act,
8 including any information about state lands managed by the
9 State Lands Division of the Department of Conservation and
10 Natural Resources.

11 (2) The Department of Finance shall update its
12 inventory and cause to be updated the other inventories
13 required by subsection (1) at least once every 3 years, but
14 the inventories shall record acquisitions of new facilities
15 and lands and significant changes in existing facilities and
16 lands as they occur. The Department of Finance shall provide
17 each agency with the most recent inventory applicable to that
18 agency or to the judicial branch. Each agency and the judicial
19 branch shall in the manner prescribed by the Department of
20 Finance, report significant changes in the inventory as they
21 occur.

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective January
23 1, 2013.
