3 Section 2. (a) Baldwin County is designated as the
4 site for a historical museum dedicated to the United States
5 Armed Forces and United States Military history, and the
6 Baldwin County Commission may take any actions it deems
7 necessary, including, but not limited to, the planning,
8 development, location, fund raising, and support of the
9 museum.

10 (b) The State Military Department may take actions
11 to support a museum as provided in this section, but this
12 section shall not be interpreted as appropriating any state
13 funds for the purpose of this section.

14 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
15 first day of the third month following its passage and
16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
