14	Section 1. (a) The following state income tax
15	credits shall apply for tax years 2012 to 2017, inclusive,
16	relating to motor vehicles using compressed natural gas (CNG)
17	or propane gas fuel:
18	(1) Up to $\frac{75}{30}$ percent of the incremental cost of
19	purchasing a motor vehicle powered by CNG or propane gas over
20	the cost of purchasing a non-CNG or a non-propane gas powered
21	vehicle.
22	(2) Up to $\frac{75}{30}$ percent of the costs of converting a
23	motor vehicle for CNG or propane gas fuel usage.
24	(b) The income tax credits allowed in this section
25	shall be applied against an Alabama taxpayer's income on a
26	dollar-for-dollar basis up to the maximum amount authorized.

1	(c) Tax credits provided in this section may be
2	carried forward from the tax year the credit is sought for an
3	additional period of 10 tax years.
4	(d) Tax credits provided in this section shall be
5	limited to the first 500 vehicles for each of the four types
6	of credits provided for in subsection (a) as determined by the
7	Department of Revenue.
8	(d) (e) The Department of Revenue may adopt rules
9	regarding the implementation and administration of this
10	section.
11	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12	first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
