Relating to Lee County; to provide for an additional court cost in cases in the circuit and district courts; and to provide for the distribution of the proceeds of the additional court costs for the operation of the offices of the circuit clerk and district attorney and for the operation of the courts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. This act shall apply only in Lee County. Section 2. In addition to any court costs now 11 authorized in the district, circuit, and juvenile courts of 12 13 Lee County, there shall be assessed and collected an 14 additional court cost of fifty dollars (\$50) in all civil and 15 criminal cases, including traffic cases in the district, 16 circuit, and juvenile courts of the county except for 17 protection from abuse cases pursuant to Chapter 5, Title 30, 18 Code of Alabama 1975.

19 Section 3. (a) Fifty percent of the additional court 20 costs collected pursuant to Section 2 shall be deposited into 21 the Lee County Circuit Clerk's Fund and used for the same 22 purposes as the fund is used on the effective date of this 23 act.

(b) Forty percent of the additional court costscollected pursuant to Section 2 shall be deposited into the

District Attorney's Fund and used for the payment of any and all expenses incurred by the district attorney for law enforcement purposes and in the discharge of the duties of the office.

5 (c) Ten percent of the additional court costs 6 collected pursuant to Section 2 shall be deposited into the 7 Judicial Fund of the Thirty-seventh Judicial Circuit and 8 expended at the request of the presiding circuit judge for any 9 lawful expense in the operation of the courts.

10 Section 4. Nothing in this act shall impair the 11 authority of a circuit or district judge to waive or to remit 12 the court costs and fees assessed pursuant to this act upon 13 the sworn and valid showing of substantial financial hardship.

14 Section 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that 15 the assessment and collection of the additional court cost 16 pursuant to this act not diminish or take the place of any 17 other source of funds for the offices of the circuit clerk, 18 district attorney, or the operation of the courts.

Section 6. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
