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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Lincoln in Talladega County.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the City of Lincoln in Talladega County are altered, rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now included, all of the following territory:

12 Commencing at a concrete right-of-way monument on 13 the North right-of-way of Interstate 20, said monument 14 representing station 883-+28.36: thence run Southerly, crossing said Interstate 20 to a concrete right-of-way 15 16 monument on the south right-of-way representing station 883+28.39 thence Easterly, along the South right-of-way of 17 18 said Interstate 20 in a curve to the right with a radius of 19 11,459.156 feet and a central angle of 17 degrees 32 minutes with a left deflection angle of 89 degrees 54 minutes 49 20 seconds for a chord distance of 20.64 feet to the point of 21 22 beginning of the parcel herein described; thence continue 23 Easterly, along said South right-of-way of Interstate 20 in the previously described curve for a chord distance of 295.95 24 feet to a point on the West right-of-way of Technology Way, 25

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forming an interior angle of 86 degrees 01 minute 45 seconds 1 2 for 350.00 feet; thence run Westerly, forming an interior 3 angle of 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds for 293.94 feet; thence run Northerly, forming an interior angle of 90 degrees 4 13 minutes 34 seconds for 329.51 feet to the point of 5 beginning, forming an interior closure angle of 93 degrees 44 6 minutes 41 seconds. 247.85 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said described land
lying and being in Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 5 East,
Talladega County, Alabama.

8 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of 9 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is 10 proposed to be annexed to the City of Lincoln is on file in 11 the office of the Judge of Probate in Talladega County, 12 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
