8 SYNOPSIS: Currently food establishments are required
9 to conspicuously display health department
10 inspection reports at a location visible to
11 customers.

12 If a food establishment operates a
13 drive-thru service, this bill would require a copy
14 of the inspection report to be displayed at the
15 outside drive-thru menu location, in addition to
16 the original being displayed inside the
17 establishment.

20 TO BE ENTITLED
21 AN ACT

23 To provide for visibility of health department
24 inspection reports to customers at food establishments.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Whenever an inspection of a food
2 establishment is made, the findings shall be recorded on the
3 inspection report form prescribed by the State Health Officer.

4 Section 2. The inspection report form shall be
5 conspicuously displayed for public view as follows:

6 (1) The original of the inspection report shall be
7 posted inside the establishment at a location visible upon
8 entrance, or at the location of the interior menu board.

9 (2) A copy shall be posted, if a food service
10 establishment operates a drive-thru window to serve food or
11 beverages to customers, and shall be visible at the drive-thru
12 menu location.

13 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
14 first day of the third month following its passage and
15 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
