The inspection report form shall be conspicuously displayed for public view as follows: 5 6 (1) The original of the inspection report shall be 7 posted inside the establishment at a location visible upon entrance, or at the location of the interior menu board. 8 9

(2) A copy shall be posted, if a food service establishment operates a drive-thru window to serve food or beverages to customers, and shall be visible at the drive-thru menu location.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
