26	Section 1. (a) The Department of Conservation and
27	Natural Resources shall extend the primitive weapon and

- archery hunting season for whitetail deer through the first two weeks after the close of regular gun season, not to include hunting with dogs.
- (b) An additional fee of three hundred forty-two
  dollars (\$342) on nonresident hunting licenses for whitetail
  deer shall be imposed and a notation shall be made on the
  license in order for the license holder to hunt pursuant to
  subsection (a). No additional fee shall be imposed for
  resident hunting licenses for hunting whitetail deer pursuant
  to subsection (a).
  - (c) The department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this act.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
