20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. (a) A state agency, any permanent or
22	temporary state office, department, division or unit, bureau,
23	board, commission task force, authority, institution, state
24	college or university, or other unit of state government,
25	whether executive, legislative, or judicial, shall stop
26	printing its annual report. Each state agency shall publish
27	its annual report on the website of the state agency.

1 (b) Each state agency shall notify all recipients of 2 the printed annual report that the annual report shall be 3 available on the website of the state agency. The state agency 4 may notify the recipients of the printed annual reports by 5 mail deposited with the United States Postal Service or by 6 email, or both.

Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 shall not
apply to Chapter 8 of Title 41 of the Code of Alabama 1975.
Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
