In a proceeding under this section, the 3 existence of a mental, physical, or developmental disability, 4 or any other disability of the parent or guardian shall not in 5 and of itself be considered child abuse or neglect unless his 6 or her actions or inactions, as with any other parent or 7 guardian, are injurious to the health, safety, or welfare of 8 the child.

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 10 first day of the third month following its passage and 11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
