Section 1. The following amendment to the

Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become

valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of

this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 47 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 8 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 47.

"(a) Senators shall be at least twenty-five years of age, and representatives twenty-one years of age at the time of their election. They shall have been citizens and residents of this state for three years and residents of their respective counties or districts for one year next before their election, if such county or district shall have been so long established; but if not, then of the county or district from which the same shall have been taken; and they shall reside in their respective counties or districts during their terms of office.

"(b) A person employed by any entity that contracts with any public two-year or four-year institution of higher education in this state may not serve in the Legislature if the person is employed by the entity in a managerial capacity and the person has direct substantive influence regarding the contract between the entity and the institution. The purpose of this restriction is to prevent potential undue influence,

3	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
4	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
5	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284
6	and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
7	Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
8	state.
9	Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
10	assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
