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ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Russell County; to amend Sections 2 and 3 of Act 343 of the 1976 Regular Session (Acts 1976, p. 388), to clarify that the State Revenue Commissioner is responsible for prescribing functions, duties, and responsibilities to ensure that property is appraised, mapped, and valued in accordance with law and to update a reference to the county revenue commissioner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Sections 2 and 3 of Act 343 of the 1976 Regular Session (Acts 1976, p. 388), are amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The State Revenue Commissioner shall prescribe the functions, duties, and responsibilities of these personnel to insure all property is properly appraised, mapped, and valued in accordance with the law.

"Section 3. The county revenue commissioner shall collect the cost of the appraisal and mapping program from the various county ad valorem tax funds. The custodian of each county ad valorem tax fund shall pay the pro rata share of the cost of appraising and mapping the property which is taxed by the custodian's ad valorem tax fund."

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
