SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, license plates for all vehicles except private passenger automobiles and pickup trucks with a gross vehicle weight under 12,000 pounds are valid for one year and are replaced at the end of the period. License plates for private passenger automobiles and pickup trucks with a gross vehicle weight under 12,000 pounds are valid for a period of five years and are replaced at the end of that period.

This bill would delete the existing law and would authorize the Commissioner of Revenue to prescribe the number of years motor vehicle license plates designs would be valid, provided that the minimum period would be five years. This bill would allow license plates of the same design to continue to be used and not replaced. This bill would not apply to a license plate with a permanent design, such as a distinctive license plate.

[^0]Relating to motor vehicle license plates; to amend Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that the Commissioner of Revenue may prescribe the number of years motor vehicle license plate designs would be valid. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:
"§32-6-62.
"(a) whe license plates for pivate passenger automobiles and pickup trucks, such truck being defined as any truck with two axles and a gross weight not exceeding 12,000 pounds, shall be valid for five yeais and shall be replaced at the end of that period. License plates for all other vehicles shall be valid for one year and shall be meplaced at the end of that period.
"(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contraiy, beginning Januaiy 1, 2007, any vehicle registered puisuant to the International Registration Plan shall be issued a license plate valid for a period of up to five years, or any number of years to be designated by the eommissioner.
"(a) Subject to subsection (b), all motor vehicle license plate designs shall be valid for not less than five
years. The Commissioner of Revenue may authorize a license plate design to be valid for more than five vears.
"(b) Subsection (a) shall not affect any law which designates a license plate design to be permanent."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
