2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Services, Inc., under the Employees' Retirement System to purchase certain prior non-qualified service credit in the system for service rendered to an employer that was not eligible for participation in the Employees' Retirement System under Section 36-27-6; and to reopen the Teachers' Retirement System and the Employees' Retirement System for purchase of certain prior service credit in the system by an active and contributing member who was employed as an employee with the United States Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Any active and contributing member of the Oxford Emergency Medical Services, Inc., that participates in the Employees' Retirement System under Section 36-27-6 of the Code of Alabama 1975, may purchase prior non-qualified service for employment rendered to Oxford Emergency Medical Services before July 14, 2009, as permitted by the IRC Section 415(n)(3)(B). Currently, under federal law the employee must have five or more years of creditable service in the Employees' Retirement System prior to purchasing up to five years' non-qualified service.

(b) No member shall receive credit for any service that the member is already credited with in the system or any

other public retirement plan, with the exception of the federal Social Security program.

- (c) Any member who is eligible to purchase service credit shall furnish to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Employees' Retirement System the full actuarially determined cost for each year of claimed service as determined by the system's actuary.
- (d) Any year of service purchased under the provisions of this section shall not be considered in determining the out-of-pocket premium amount charged to retirees under the provisions of Section 16-25A-8.1 or Section 36-29-19.7, Code of Alabama 1975. Also, any service purchased under this section shall not entitle a member to be eligible for benefits under either the PEEHIP or SEIB any earlier than the member could have reached eligibility under the plan without the service purchased under the provisions of this section.

Section 2. (a) Any active and contributing member of the Teachers' Retirement System or the Employees' Retirement System who has 10 years or more of credible service in either system may claim and purchase service credit in the system for up to 10 years of prior service for employment as an employee with the United States Department of Agriculture Farm Service Agency if the member complies with the conditions prescribed in subsection (b). No member shall receive credit for any

service that the member is already credited with in the system or any other public retirement plan, with the exception of the federal Social Security program.

(b) Any member who is eligible to purchase service credit pursuant to subsection (a) shall pay to the Secretary-Treasurer of the system, within one year from the effective date of this act, the full actuarially determined cost for each year of claimed service as determined by the system's actuary.

Section 3. Any year of service purchased under the provisions of this act shall not be considered in determining the out-of-pocket premium amount charged to retirees under the provisions of Section 16-25A-8.1 or Section 36-29-19.7, Code of Alabama 1975. Also, any service purchased under this act shall not entitle a member to be eligible for benefits under either the Public Education Employees' Health Insurance Plan or the State Employees' Health Insurance Plan any earlier than the member could have reached eligibility under the plan without the service purchased under the provisions of this act.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming a law.
