8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, one percent of the gross
9 amount collected on the \$.10 on each \$100 of the
10 assessed value of taxable property for the relief
11 of needy Confederate soldiers and sailors, resident
12 citizens of the state and their widows, is expended
13 by the Alabama Historical Commission for capital
14 improvements and maintenance at Confederate
15 Memorial Park at Mountain Creek, Chilton County.

16 This bill would provide for the entire one
17 percent gross amount collected on the \$.10 on each
18 \$100 of the assessed value of taxable property to
19 be allocated to the Alabama Historical Commission
20 to be expended on certain properties.

22 A BILL
23 TO BE ENTITLED
24 AN ACT

26 To amend Section 40-8-3, Code of Alabama 1975,
27 relating to the allocation of certain proceeds of a state ad

1 valorem tax to the Alabama Historical Commission for the
2 Confederate Memorial Park at Mountain Creek; to provide for
3 the entire allocation to be allocated to the Alabama
4 Historical Commission to be expended on certain properties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

6 Section 1. Section 40-8-3, Code of Alabama 1975, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 "§40-8-3.

9 There is hereby levied for the purpose and upon the
10 property hereinafter named and not specifically exempted from
11 taxation annual taxes, as follows:

12 (1) For the maintenance of the public schools of
13 this state, \$.30 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable
14 property.

15 (2) For the relief of needy Confederate soldiers and
16 sailors, resident citizens of Alabama and their widows, \$.10
17 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable property of
18 which one percent of the gross amount collected will be
19 ~~expended by the Alabama Historical Commission to provide for~~
20 ~~capital improvements and maintenance at the Confederate~~
21 ~~Memorial Park at Mountain Creek, Chilton County, Alabama.~~
22 allocated to the Alabama Historical Commission to be expended
23 as follows:

24 a. \$100,000 for the Historic Blakeley State Park;

25 b. \$50,000 for Fort Gaines;

26 c. \$100,000 for Tannehill Ironworks;

27 d. \$100,000 for the Decatur Civil War Walking Trail;

1 e. \$50,000 for the Birmingham Civil Rights Museum;

2 f. The remainder to Confederate Memorial Park.

3 (3) For the use of the state and to raise revenue
4 therefor, \$.25 on each \$100 of the assessed value of taxable
5 property.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
