15	collection of a solicitor's fee payable to the Solicitor's

17	fees and court costs payable to the Fair Trial Tax Fund in

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. Section 45-2-80.01, Code of Alabama 1975,
22	is amended to read as follows:
23	"§45-2-80.01.
24	"(a) In all juvenile cases, traffic, criminal, and
25	quasi-criminal cases in the juvenile, district, circuit, and
26	municipal courts in Baldwin County in the Twenty-eighth
27	Judicial Circuit, a docket fee, hereinafter referred to as a

1 solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each case. The fees, 2 when collected, shall be distributed monthly to the Solicitor's Fund or District Attorney's Fund in the county 3 where the fee is collected or to the fund that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the solicitor's fee. The 5 6 solicitor's fee shall be in an amount equal to all docket fees 7 or court costs which are assessed upon an adjudication of quilt in a criminal case and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund.

"(b) The solicitor's fee shall be collected in all criminal cases where the defendant is adjudged guilty, a bond forfeited, a penalty imposed, or where there is issued any alias or capias warrant of arrest. The solicitor's fee shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any other fees or costs. The solicitor's fee shall not be waived or remitted unless the defendant proves to the reasonable satisfaction of the sentencing judge that the defendant is not capable of paying the fee within the reasonably foreseeable future.

"(c) In all civil cases in the circuit and district courts in Baldwin County, a docket fee, hereinafter referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each case. The fees, when collected, shall be distributed monthly as follows: Three dollars (\$3) from each case to the office of the Circuit Clerk in Baldwin County and the remainder of each fee to the District Attorney's Solicitor's Fund in the county where collected. The solicitor's fee in civil cases shall be in the same amount as the docket fee or court costs which are

1	assessed in civil circuit and district court cases in Baldwin
2	County and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund.
3	"(c)(d) The solicitor's fee may be expended, as the
4	district attorney sees fit, for the payment of any and all
5	expenses incurred by the district attorney for law enforcement
6	and in the discharge of the duties of the office in the county
7	in which it was collected."
8	Section 2. This act shall become effective
9	immediately following its passage and approval by the
10	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
