24	payable by the debtor, to the outstanding debt for the
25	collection fee incurred or to be incurred.
26	(c) This bill is not applicable to companies
27	providing cable TV or Internet services

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
