13 Relating to Pike County; authorizing the county
14 commission to levy an additional ad valorem tax outside the
15 corporate limits of the City of Troy and the City of
16 Brundidge; and providing for a referendum.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment
19 No. 373 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, the Pike
20 County Commission may levy, in addition to any other tax, an
21 ad valorem tax outside the corporate limits of the City of
22 Troy and the City of Brundidge in the amount of two mills on
23 each dollar of taxable property in the county. The revenue
24 from the additional tax shall be paid to the county general
25 fund to be distributed as follows:

26 (1) Ninety percent to the Pike County Firefighters
27 Association.

1 (2) Ten percent to the Pike County General Fund for
2 related administration costs.

3 Section 2. The increase in the rate of the tax as
4 provided by this act is subject to the approval of a majority
5 of the qualified electors of the county not residing in the
6 City of Troy or the City of Brundidge who vote on the proposed
7 increase at the next general, primary, constitutional, or
8 special election held for that purpose.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
