24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. At any time Congress fails to either
26	levy, eliminate, or reduce the tax imposed on taxable fuel as
27	imposed and defined under 26 U.S.C. § 4081 and § 4083, as

amended, an amount equivalent to the reduction in the tax 1 imposed on taxable fuel in effect at such time shall be 2 automatically levied and collected by the state and the 3 4 proceeds deposited into the state road and bridge fund. If Congress reauthorizes or restores the federal tax imposed on 5 taxable fuel to the amounts in effect at the time of the 6 7 reduction, as determined by the Commissioner of Revenue, then the state levy and collection shall be automatically adjusted 8 accordingly. 9

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective 11 immediately following its passage and approval by the 12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
