1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. (a) Immediately upon an attorney's 3 election to the House of Representatives or Senate of the 4 Alabama Legislature, he or she shall forfeit his or her 5 Alabama State Bar license to practice law in the state.

6 (b) A member of the House of Representatives or 7 Senate of the Legislature who forfeited his or her Alabama 8 State Bar license pursuant to subsection (a) and is no longer 9 serving in the Legislature may retake and pass the Alabama 10 State Bar examination and complete 24 hours or more of 11 continuing legal education for relicensure as an attorney in 12 the state.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
