8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to
9 Amendment 344 to the Constitution of Alabama of
10 1901, now appearing as Section 2, Local Amendments,
11 Blount County, of the Official Recompilation of the
12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended,
13 specifying that the Legislature, by general or
14 local law, may fix, regulate, and alter the costs
15 and charges of court in Blount County and provide
16 for their distribution in Blount County.

22 Relating to Blount County; to propose an amendment
23 to Amendment 344 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now
24 appearing as Section 2, Local Amendments, Blount County, of
25 the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of
26 1901, as amended, specifying that the Legislature, by general
27 or local law, may fix, regulate, and alter the costs and

1 charges of court in Blount County and provide for their
2 distribution in Blount County.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. The following amendment to the
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
6 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
7 this act are fulfilled:

8 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 "Amendment 344.

10 "The legislature may, from time to time, by general
11 or local laws applicable to or operative in Blount ~~county~~
12 County and approved by a majority of the qualified electors of
13 Blount ~~county~~ County at a referendum election, fix, regulate,
14 and alter the costs and charges of court and the fees,
15 commissions, allowances, and salaries, including the method
16 and basis of their compensation, to be charged or received by
17 the probate judge, the ~~tax assessor~~ circuit clerk, and the ~~tax~~
18 ~~collector~~ revenue commissioner of Blount ~~county~~ County; and
19 may place any or all of such officers on a salary and provide
20 for the fees, commissions, allowances, and percentages
21 collectible by such officers to be paid into the treasury from
22 which their salaries are paid.

23 "In the event this amendment is approved and a
24 majority of the qualified electors of ~~said the~~ the county who vote
25 thereon vote in favor of the adoption of this amendment when
26 it is submitted, then any law theretofore passed which places
27 any officers in Blount ~~county~~ County on a salary basis, or any

1 law fixing, regulating, and altering the costs and charges of
2 court and the fees, commissions, allowances, and salaries of
3 any officer in Blount ~~county~~ County, may become effective
4 without any other election having been held thereon. In the
5 event this amendment is approved and a majority of the
6 qualified electors of ~~said~~ the county who vote thereon vote
7 against its approval, then such act or acts shall have no
8 further force or effect. The purpose of the amendment of
9 Amendment 344 is to specifically provide that the Legislature,
10 after the ratification of this amendment, may fix, regulate,
11 and alter the costs and charges of court in Blount County and
12 provide for their distribution."

13 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
14 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
16 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
17 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
18 state.

19 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
20 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
21 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
22 following description of the substance or subject matter of
23 the proposed constitutional amendment:

24 "Relating to Blount County, proposing an amendment
25 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, specifying that the
26 Legislature, by general or local law, may fix, regulate, and

1 alter the costs and charges of court in Blount County and
2 provide for their distribution in Blount County.

3 "Proposed by Act _____."

4 This description shall be followed by the following
5 language:
