Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama 26 27 of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the

1 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 2 Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general law whose purpose or effect would be to require a 3 4 new or increased expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard to a local 5 6 governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote 7 unless: it comes within one of a number of specified exceptions; it is approved by the 8 affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates 9 10 funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to 11 the entity for the purpose.

12 The purpose or effect of this bill would be 13 to require a new or increased expenditure of local 14 funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, 15 the bill does not require approval of a local 16 governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to 17 become effective because it comes within one of the 18 specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

one year, or both fine and imprisonment; and on a third or subsequent conviction of a violation of this section, shall be punished by a fine of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) nor more than three thousand dollars (\$3,000) or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months one year, or both fine and imprisonment."

Section 2. (a) A person commits the crime of
aggravated cruelty to animals if the person violates Section
13A-11-14, Code of Alabama 1975, and the act of cruelty or
neglect was especially heinous, atrocious, cruel, or involved
the infliction of torture to the animal.

(b) For purposes of this section, torture is the act of doing physical injury to an animal by the infliction of inhumane treatment or gross physical abuse meant to cause the animal intensive or prolonged pain, serious bodily injury, or death as a result of the act.

17 (c) Aggravated cruelty to animals is a Class C18 felony.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
