24	Section 1. The Supreme Court shall adopt rules to
25	promote the prompt, efficient, and cost-effective resolution
26	of civil actions. The rules shall: (1) apply to civil actions
27	in circuit courts in which the amount in controversy,

inclusive of all claims for damages of any kind, whether actual or exemplary, a penalty, attorney's fees, expenses, costs, interest, or any other type of damage of any kind, does not exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000); and (2) address the need for lowering discovery costs in these actions and the procedure for ensuring that these actions will be expedited in the civil justice system.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 9 first day of the third month following its passage and 10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
