Relating to Russell County; to provide that the Sheriff of Russell County, at his or her discretion, may provide a retiring law enforcement officer in good standing, including a supernumerary sheriff, with his or her badge and pistol; and to provide for retroactive effect.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Any individual employed by the Russell 10 County Sheriff's Office as a law enforcement officer for a 11 period of 10 years or more who retires from the department in 12 good standing, including a supernumerary sheriff, may receive 13 from the sheriff, at his or her discretion, without cost, a 14 retired badge and a pistol, provided the pistol is furnished 15 by the department.

Section 2. This act shall have retroactive effect to any action taken prior to the effective date of this act.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
