24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any contrary
26	provision of law, no agency of the State of Alabama, political
27	subdivision of Alabama, employee of either acting in his or

1 her official capacity, or member of the Alabama National Guard 2 or the Alabama State Defense Force, when such a member is serving in the Alabama National Guard or an official state 3 duty, shall knowingly aid an agency of the United States Armed Forces in the detention of any citizen pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 5 6 1541 as provided by the National Defense Authorization Act for 7 fiscal year 2012 (P.L. 112-81, § 1021), if such aid would knowingly place any state agency, political subdivision, 8 employee of such state agency or political subdivision, or 9 10 aforementioned member of the Alabama National Guard or the Alabama State Defense Force in violation of the United States 11 12 Constitution, the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, any 13 provision of the Code of Alabama 1975, any act of the 14 Legislature, or any regulation of the Alabama Administrative 15 Code.

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(b) The provisions of this section shall not apply to participation by state or local law enforcement or the Alabama National Guard or Alabama State Defense Force in joint task forces, partnerships, or other similar cooperative agreements with federal law enforcement as long as they are not for the purpose of participating in such detentions under \$ 1021 of the National Defense Authorization Act for fiscal year 2012.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
