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8	To propose a local amendment to the Constitution of
9	Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to Baldwin County, to
10	authorize the county to expend any revenues at any time
11	derived by it from the operation of any landfill for certain
12	specified purposes, to continue to charge and alter tipping
13	fees and other charges for the use of a landfill, and to
14	deposit, or cause to be deposited, any or all revenues in its
15	general fund or any other fund or account maintained by it, or
16	in any depositary, fiduciary, or trust account maintained by
17	it with any bank or other financial institution, and to
18	ratify, validate, and confirm all previous actions taken by
19	the county and its governing body in connection with the
20	operation of any landfill.
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. The following amendment to the
23	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
24	valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
25	this act are fulfilled:
26	PROPOSED AMENDMENT

1 (a) Baldwin County shall have the power to expend 2 any revenues heretofore or hereafter derived by it from the operation by it of any landfill, for the purposes of paying 3 4 costs of operating and maintaining a landfill, promoting the economic and industrial development of the county, and 5 6 construction of roads in and for the county directly related 7 to specific economic and industrial development projects. The revenues shall include all moneys paid to or received by the 8 county from any source in connection with the operation of a 9 10 landfill, including, but not limited to, tipping fees and other charges heretofore or hereafter imposed by the county 11 for use of any landfill, and any payments heretofore or 12 13 hereafter received by the county from any political 14 subdivision, public corporation, agency, or instrumentality of 15 either the State of Alabama or the United States of America.

(b) The county may hereafter continue to levy or 16 17 charge tipping fees and other charges for the use of any landfill operated by the county, at a rate in an amount as the 18 governing body may determine, and to alter the tipping fees 19 and charges at any time and from time to time. The fees and 20 21 charges may be uniform for all users of the landfill or may be 22 fixed in different amounts for different classes or categories 23 of the users. The county, at the discretion of its governing 24 body, may deposit, or cause to be deposited, in its general 25 fund or in any other fund or account maintained by it, any or 26 all of the revenues derived by it from the operation of any 27 such landfill, and may deposit or retain any or all revenues

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in any depositary, fiduciary, or trust account maintained by
 it with any bank or other financial institution.

3 (c) All powers hereby granted to the county or to 4 its governing body, as the case may be, shall be in addition 5 to, and not in derogation of, any other powers heretofore or 6 hereafter granted by law to the county, and may be exercised 7 without regard to any other conditions, limitations, 8 restrictions, or requirements heretofore otherwise imposed by 9 law on the county or its governing body, as the case may be.

10 (d) There are hereby ratified, validated, and confirmed all actions heretofore taken by the county or by its 11 governing body, as the case may be, in connection with the 12 13 operation by the county of any landfill, including, without 14 limitation, the levy or charge and collection by the county of 15 any tipping fees or charges in connection with the operation or any such landfill, the deposit or retention by the county 16 17 of any or all revenues derived by it from the operation of any such landfill in any fund or account created, held, or 18 maintained by the county, including, without limitation, its 19 general fund, or any depositary, fiduciary, or trust account 20 21 maintained by the county with any bank or other financial institution, and the expenditure by the county, for any 22 otherwise lawful purpose, of any or all such revenues. 23

(e) The provisions of this amendment are and shall
be self-executing, and authorization from or any other action
by the Legislature shall not be a prerequisite to the
continued levy or charge by the county of tipping fees and

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1 other charges in respect of any landfill, or to the use or 2 expenditure of the revenues therefrom; but notwithstanding any contrary provision of either Section 104 or Section 105 of the 3 4 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 104 and 105, respectively, of the Official Recompilation of the 5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, the Legislature 6 7 shall have the power to enact general, special, or local laws supplemental hereto or in furtherance of the purpose hereof; 8 provided, that no such special or local law shall be subject 9 10 to the provisions of Section 106 of the Constitution, as 11 amended.

12 Section 2. An election on the proposed amendment is 13 ordered to held on November 6, 2012, (a) in Baldwin County, or 14 (b) if and only if so required at a statewide referendum, in 15 accordance with the provisions of Amendment No. 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 16 17 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 18 19 state.

20 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 21 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 22 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 23 following description of the substance or subject matter of 24 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment
to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, authorizing the county
to use any revenues derived by it from the operation of any

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county landfill for certain purposes, including promoting the 1 2 economic and industrial development of the county and constructing roads in and for the county directly related to 3 4 specific economic and industrial development projects, and to continue to levy tipping fees and charges for the use of any 5 such county landfill and validating all actions heretofore 6 7 taken by the county in connection with the operation of any such county landfill. 8 "Proposed by Act ." 9

10This description shall be followed by the following11language:
