Relating to Greene County; authorizing the county commission to levy an additional ad valorem tax and providing for a referendum.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment No. 373 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, the Greene County Commission may levy, in addition to any other tax, an ad valorem tax in the amount of three mills on each dollar of taxable property in the county. The revenue from the additional tax shall be paid to the county general fund for educational purposes.

Section 2. The increase in the rate of the tax pursuant to this act is subject to the approval of a majority of the qualified electors of the county who vote on the proposed increase at the next general, primary, constitutional, or special election held for that purpose.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
