Section 1. (a) Every local and state law enforcement agency shall provide annual recertification training relating to the use of deadly force for each law enforcement officer, as defined by Section 36-21-40, Code of Alabama 1975, employed by the agency.

(b) The Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission shall approve a training course that satisfies the requirements of this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
