"(b) It shall be unlawful for any automated or 21 22 pre-recorded communication initiated, conducted, or 23 transmitted through an automated telephone dialing service to 24 be conducted without providing clear notice at the ending of 25 the phone call that the communication was a paid political

advertisement and clearly identifying the person, nonprofit corporation, entity, principal campaign committee, or political action committee that paid for such communication.

"(c) It shall be unlawful for any person or entity
to knowingly misrepresent, in any automated or pre-recorded
communication that is a political advertisement and that is
initiated via an automated telephone dialing service, the
identification of the person, nonprofit corporation, entity,
principal campaign committee, or political action committee
that paid for such communication.

"(d) The Attorney General of the State of Alabama shall have full power to investigate and enforce violations of this section and any owner, employer, agent, or representative of any automated dialing service found to be in violation of this section shall be guilty upon conviction of a Class A misdemeanor as provided in Section 17-17-35(a)."

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 18 first day of the third month following its passage and 19 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
