To require the Comptroller to post and maintain a statewide database on the Open.Alabama.gov website of each request for a bid or proposal for a public contract by the State of Alabama, an agency, board, commission, or department of the state, the State Board of Education, a public college or trade school, or a public university receiving state or federally appropriated funds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Comptroller shall establish and maintain and post on the Open.Alabama.gov website a statewide database of each request for a bid or proposal for a public contract by the State of Alabama, an agency, board, commission, or department of the state, the State Board of Education, a public college or trade school, or a public university receiving state or federally appropriated funds.

- (b) The database shall be a public record and may be viewed by any citizen, either in person or via the Open.Alabama.gov website.
- (c) Each request for a bid or proposal shall remain available on the website until the last posting date required by law has expired.
- (d) There shall not be a charge for access to the database.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the sixth month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
