Relating to the Alabama Law Institute; to authorize the Alabama Law Institute to receive direct grants or contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies, educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law Institute.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 29-8-6 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

14 §29-8-6.

The Alabama Law Institute may establish a special fund in the State Treasury to receive direct grants or contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies, educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law Institute. The funds in the special fund are continuously appropriated for the exclusive use of the Law Institute, shall be maintained separately, and shall be in addition to any other funds appropriated to the Law Institute.

Section 2. The Alabama Law Institute shall provide a public report of all funds received pursuant to this act. The
