5 Relating to the Alabama Law Institute; to authorize
6 the Alabama Law Institute to receive direct grants or
7 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or
8 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies,
9 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law
10 Institute.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. Section 29-8-6 is added to the Code of
13 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

14 §29-8-6.

15 The Alabama Law Institute may establish a special
16 fund in the State Treasury to receive direct grants or
17 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or
18 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies,
19 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law
20 Institute. The funds in the special fund are continuously
21 appropriated for the exclusive use of the Law Institute, shall
22 be maintained separately, and shall be in addition to any
23 other funds appropriated to the Law Institute.

24 Section 2. The Alabama Law Institute shall provide a
25 public report of all funds received pursuant to this act. The

1 public report shall be made on the website of the Alabama Law
2 Institute.

3 Section 3. This act shall become effective
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
