4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To establish the crime of disarming a law
6 enforcement or corrections officer; and in connection
7 therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement
8 of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the
9 meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of
10 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official
11 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
12 amended.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. (a) A person commits the crime of
15 disarming a law enforcement or corrections officer if the
16 person intentionally removes a firearm or weapon from a law
17 enforcement or corrections officer or deprives a law
18 enforcement or corrections officer of the use of a firearm or
19 weapon when the officer is acting within the scope of his or
20 her duties and the person knows or reasonably should have
21 known that the individual is a law enforcement or corrections
22 officer.

23 (b) The crime of disarming a law enforcement or
24 corrections officer is a Class C felony.

1 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its
2 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
3 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
4 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now
5 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of
6 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the
7 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
8 existing crime.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
10 first day of the third month following its passage and
11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
