12	pastor and congregation of Bethlehem Baptist Church located in
13	Centreville, Alabama, on celebrating a Sesquicentennial

23	Reverend S. V. McGinnis as the first pastor, and he named the
24	church Bethlehem; and

26	schoolhouse from logs at the cost of \$2.00; years later, it
27	was torn down and replaced with a frame building; in 1936, the

1 church was rebuilt for a third time on a site that remains the 2 current place of worship; and

WHEREAS, Bethlehem Baptist Church has positively impacted countless lives and will continue to serve as a beacon of light and a pillar of faith for those within the community; now therefore,
