8 RECOGNIZING JULY 9, 2018, AS THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY
9 OF THE U. S. ARMY WARRANT OFFICER CORPS.

11 WHEREAS, The United States Army Warrant Officer
12 Corps was established on July 9, 1918, and this year marks the
13 100th Anniversary of the Corps; and

14 WHEREAS, the United States Army Warrant Officers
15 Association was formed in July 1972, and this year marks the
16 46th anniversary of the association; and

17 WHEREAS, the United States Army Warrant Officers
18 Association was established to foster a spirit of patriotism
19 and devotion to duty among its members, recommend programs for
20 the improvement of the Army, distribute professional
21 information among warrant officers, promote the technical and
22 social welfare of our soldiers and promote a spirit of true
23 comradeship among its members; and

24 WHEREAS, the United States Army Warrant Officers
25 Association joins 33 other military member organizations
26 totaling more than 5.5 million members seeking to support and
27 preserve laws, funds, and policies which are fair and proper

11 approval and presents these views to the appropriate
