WHEREAS, highest commendations and congratulations

WHEREAS, Aidan, at age 12, decided she wanted to help parents who find themselves at a hospital under emergency circumstances without the time to pack a bag of toiletries, so she initiated the 13:13 Project, named for the Bible verse from 1 Corinthians 13:13, "And now these three remain: faith, hope, and love. But the greatest of these is love."; and

WHEREAS, Aidan began collecting toiletry items to pack into "anchor bags" that were donated to the Huntsville Hospital for Women and Children; the bags were named after Hebrews 6:19, "We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure."; and

WHEREAS, receiving support from local businesses and through the involvement of her church, Mt. Zion Baptist, the 13:13 Project grew, and the organization began feeding parents who were at the hospital with a sick or injured child after Aidan sold shirts with the project logo to raise the money for meal vouchers; so far the 13:13 Project has donated more than \$3,000 to the Huntsville Hospital Foundation, giving Aidan's project major donor status; and

WHEREAS, Aidan is regarded as a hero by her family and friends for her unending enthusiasm, generosity, and entrepreneurship in seeing a need through her own difficult experiences and finding a way to make a difference in other's lives; and
