8 CREATING THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON
9 21ST CENTURY WORKFORCE.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
12 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That there is created the
13 Lieutenant Governor's Commission on 21st Century Workforce.

14 (a) The membership of the commission shall consist
15 of the following:

16 (1) The Lieutenant Governor.

17 (2) Three members of the House of Representatives,
18 appointed by the Lieutenant Governor.

19 (3) Three members of the Senate, appointed by the
20 Lieutenant Governor.

21 (b) The Lieutenant Governor shall coordinate the
22 appointments to assure that the membership of the commission
23 is inclusive and reflects the racial, gender, geographic,
24 urban, rural, and economic diversity of the state.

25 (c) (1) Appointments to the commission shall be made
26 within 30 days after the effective date of this act.

1 (2) The Lieutenant Governor shall serve as chair of
2 the commission.

3 (3) At the first meeting, to be called by the
4 Lieutenant Governor, the commission shall elect a vice chair
5 and other officers as determined by the commission, and shall
6 set dates, times, and locations of subsequent meetings.

7 (d) The commission shall study and, from time to
8 time, make recommendations to the Legislature regarding the
9 provision and coordination of workforce development efforts
10 across state government.

11 (e) The House of Representatives, the Senate, and
12 the Legislative Services Agency shall provide the necessary
13 staff and support to the commission to perform its duties.

14 (f) Members of the commission shall be entitled to
15 their legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses
16 for each day they attend a meeting of the commission in
17 accordance with Amendment 871 of the Constitution of Alabama
18 of 1901.
