1 (2) The Lieutenant Governor shall serve as chair of the commission.

- (3) At the first meeting, to be called by the Lieutenant Governor, the commission shall elect a vice chair and other officers as determined by the commission, and shall set dates, times, and locations of subsequent meetings.
- (d) The commission shall study and, from time to time, make recommendations to the Legislature regarding the provision and coordination of workforce development efforts across state government.
- (e) The House of Representatives, the Senate, and the Legislative Services Agency shall provide the necessary staff and support to the commission to perform its duties.
- (f) Members of the commission shall be entitled to their legislative compensation, per diem, and travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the commission in accordance with Amendment 871 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901.
