9	AWARENESS DAY.

11	WHEREAS, car surfing involves the dangerous riding
12	on the outside of a moving vehicle being driven by another
13	person; the car surfer may be hitching the ride on any part of
14	the exterior, including the roof, rear, hood, side of the
15	vehicle, or may be towed by holding onto the moving vehicle
16	riding on a skateboard, bicycle, or other item; and
17	WHEREAS, the risks associated with this dangerous
18	behavior result in numerous injuries and deaths annually;
19	traumatic brain injury is the most common type of injury due
20	to the nature of an unprotected fall from a moving vehicle
21	onto pavement or asphalt; and
22	WHEREAS, for the car surfer, the unique thrill of
23	the ride and the infamy of the social media posts on YouTube
24	and elsewhere seem to be worth the recklessness of this
25	behavior; and

WHEREAS, young Chase Davis of Columbiana died on 1 2 July 1, 2017, as a result of an accident caused by car 3 surfing; and WHEREAS, the public, particularly young residents, 4 5 should be mindful of the dangers of car surfing; now therefore, 6 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in memory of the life of Chase 8 Davis, as a continuing memorial to the many other loved ones 9 10 who have suffered the same fate, and as an annual reminder of the tragic consequences of car surfing, July 1 each year is 11 12 hereby designated as Car Surfing Death Awareness Day in 13 Alabama in hopes of increasing the public's awareness of the 14 dangers of car surfing and preventing injuries and deaths

caused by this dangerous behavior.
