26	month, and the. The chair of the board shall be entitled to
27	receive five hundred fifty dollars (\$550) per month. The board

shall meet not less than once per month and no more than four times per month. In addition to the monthly per diem as fixed herein, the chair of the board shall be entitled to receive an additional per diem in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) monthly for other duties of the chair. The chair shall be present at all examinations given by the clerk of the board. The board shall have the power to appoint clerical assistants and engage legal counsel of its own choice, who shall be paid by the county. No clerical assistant shall have any other employment other than with the board."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
