13	Relating to Clay County; creating the Clay County
14	Animal Control Authority and providing for said authority's
15	composition, terms, duties, and powers; to provide for the

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. There is hereby created the Clay County
19	Animal Control Authority for Clay County, Alabama. Said
20	authority is created for the purpose of providing for animal
21	control shelter services for dogs, cats, and other
22	domesticated animals in Clay County. For the purposes of this
23	act, the term "animal control shelter services" shall mean the
24	control, removal, and containment of stray, at-large, or
25	surrendered domesticated animals.
26	Section 2. (a) The authority shall be governed by a
27	Board of Directors consisting of ten members, who shall be

residents of Clay County. Each member of the Clay County

Commission shall appoint one of the ten members; each member

of the legislative delegation serving Clay County shall

appoint a member; and the mayor of the City of Ashland and the

mayor of the City of Lineville shall each appoint one member.

Subsequently, vacancies on the board shall be appointed by the

same appointing authority who made the initial appointment.

- (b) The initial terms of the directors shall be staggered, three shall be for a term of two years, three shall be for a term of three years, and four shall be for a term of four years.
- (c) Within 30 days following the enactment date of this legislation, the appointing authorities shall submit in writing the name and address of the members of the board of directors to the Probate Judge and such appointments shall be filed and maintained in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Clay County. At the organization meeting of the members of the board of directors, members shall select by lot the initial term for which each shall serve. The terms shall also be filed with the Judge of Probate. The members shall also elect from among themselves, a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. Each shall serve a period of one year, or until a successor is elected to serve. Neither shall be bonded, except the treasurer, who shall obtain bond as an official. The terms of all members, subsequent to the initial terms, shall be four years. Members shall not serve more than two four-year terms.

1 Section 3. The authority is hereby authorized to 2 enter into contracts with governmental agencies or public or private entities for the operation and maintenance of a county 3 pound or animal shelter. The authority shall have the power to 4 5 solicit and receive contributions, donations, and grants of 6 money, equipment, supplies, and services from other government 7 entities, corporations, partnerships, or individuals. All such contributions, donations, and grants, including any money set 8 aside for, or appropriated to, the authority by the county commission or the Legislature, shall be used solely for the purpose of providing animal control shelter services in Clay 11 County. 12

Section 4. The county commission shall have no obligation to provide animal control shelter services except to the extent required by this act.

Section 5. The provisions of this act are severable. Should any part of this act be declared unconstitutional, the part which remains shall not be affected.

Section 6. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
