An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the 8 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 9 10 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 11 12 state. 13 Section 3.
