23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. Section 31-2-13, Code of Alabama 1975, is
25	amended to read as follows:
26	"§31-2-13.

"(a) Military leave of absence. - All officers and 1 2 employees of the State of Alabama, or of any county, municipality, or other agency or political subdivision 3 thereof, or officers or employees of any public or private business or industry who are active members of the Alabama 5 National Guard, Naval Militia, the Alabama State Guard 6 7 organized in lieu of the National Guard, the National Disaster Medical System, or of any other reserve component of the armed 8 forces uniformed services of the United States, shall be 9 10 entitled to military leave of absence from their respective civil duties and occupations on all days that they are engaged 11 12 in field or coast defense or other training or on other 13 service ordered under the National Defense Act, the Public 14 Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response of 15 2002, or of the federal laws governing the United States reserves, without loss of pay, time, efficiency rating, annual 16 17 vacation, or sick leave. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no person granted a leave of absence with pay shall be paid for 18 more than 168 working hours per calendar year, and those 19 persons shall be entitled, in addition thereto, to be paid for 20 21 no more than 168 working hours at any one time while called by 22 the Governor to duty in the active service of the state. This 23 section shall apply to all schools and institutions of 24 learning supported by state funds.

"(b) Credit for active federal service. - Service in the National Guard or Naval Militia of Alabama, when called, drafted, or ordered into the service of the United States,

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shall be considered as equivalent service in the Alabama

National Guard or Naval Militia for any and all state purposes

regarding privileges, honors, pay, allowances, and exemptions

provided by law for members of the National Guard and Naval

Militia of Alabama."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the

first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
